



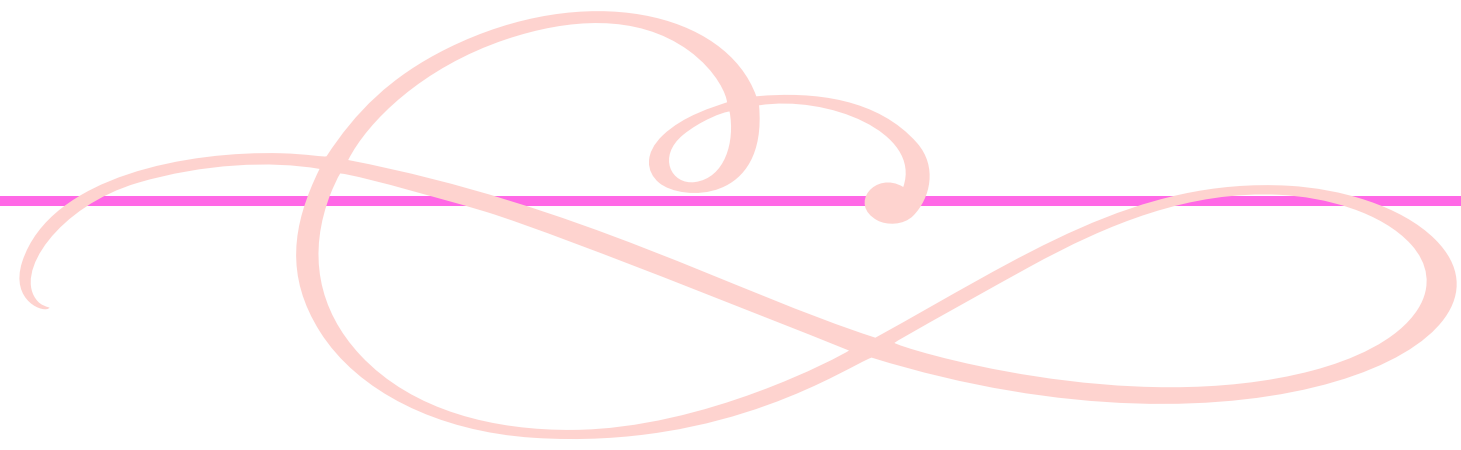

- Quote keeper



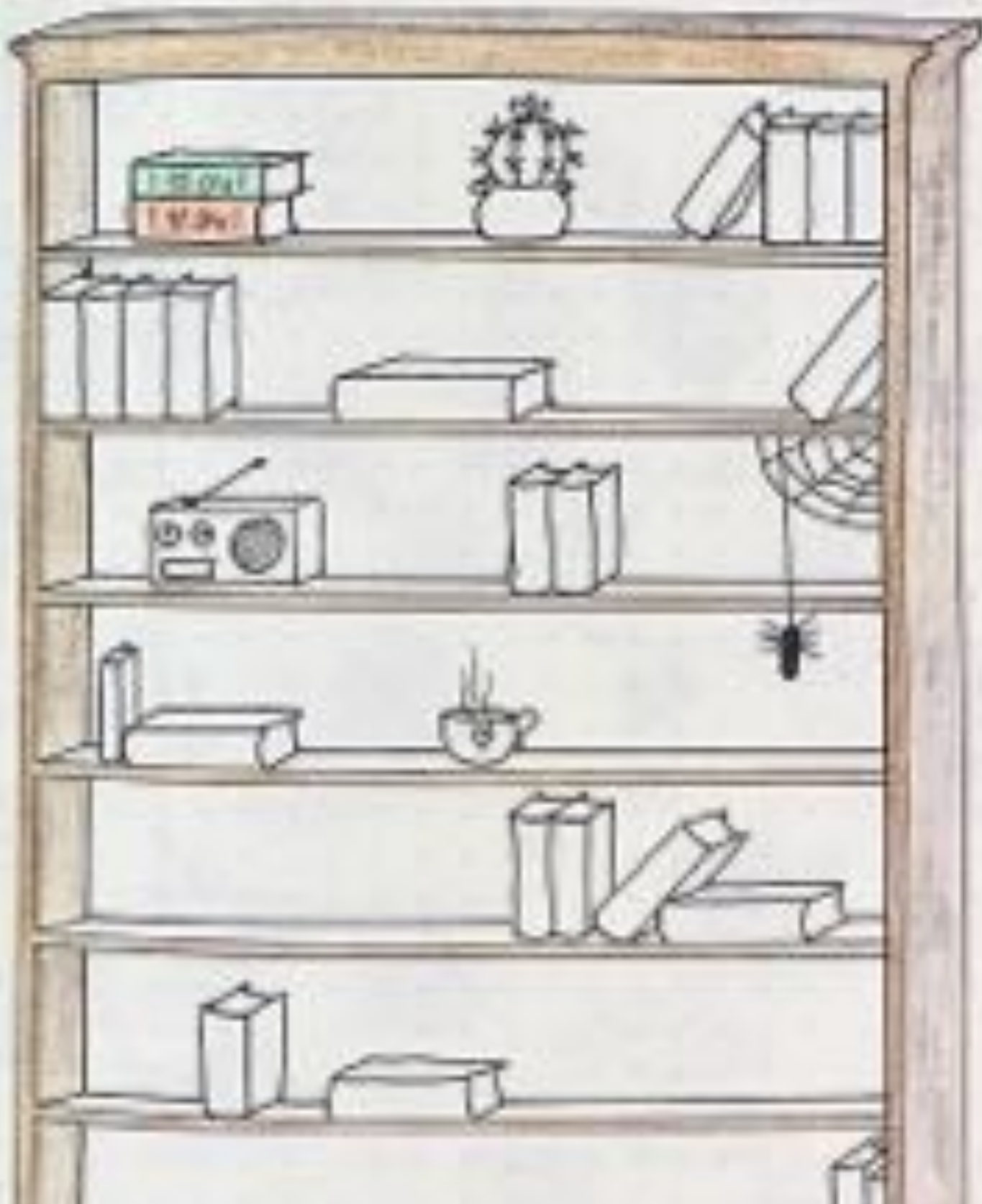

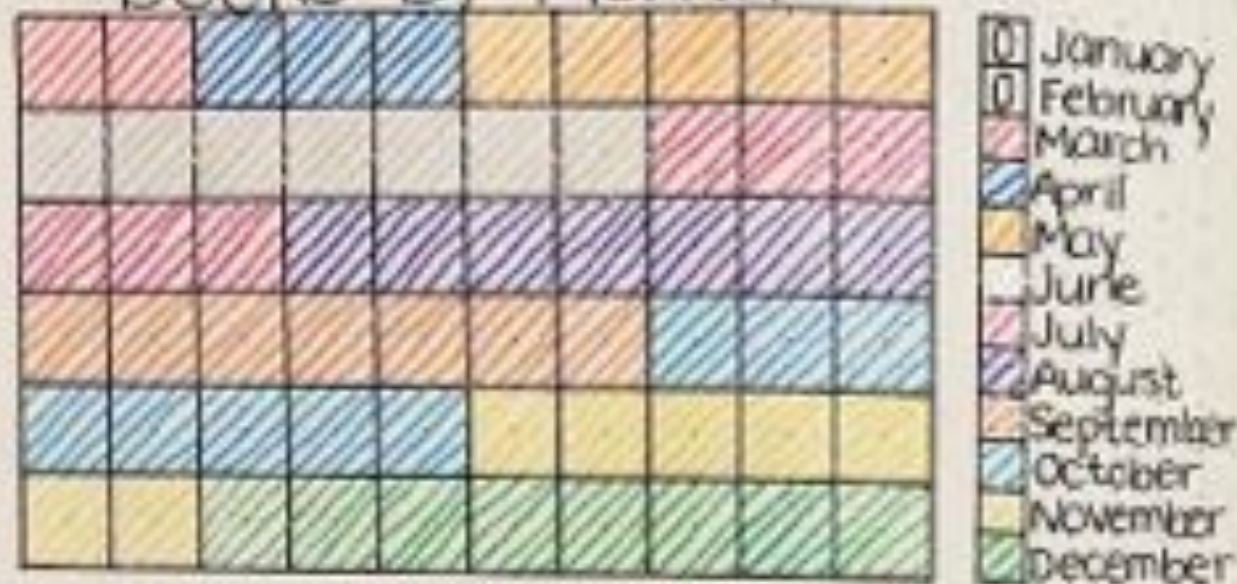

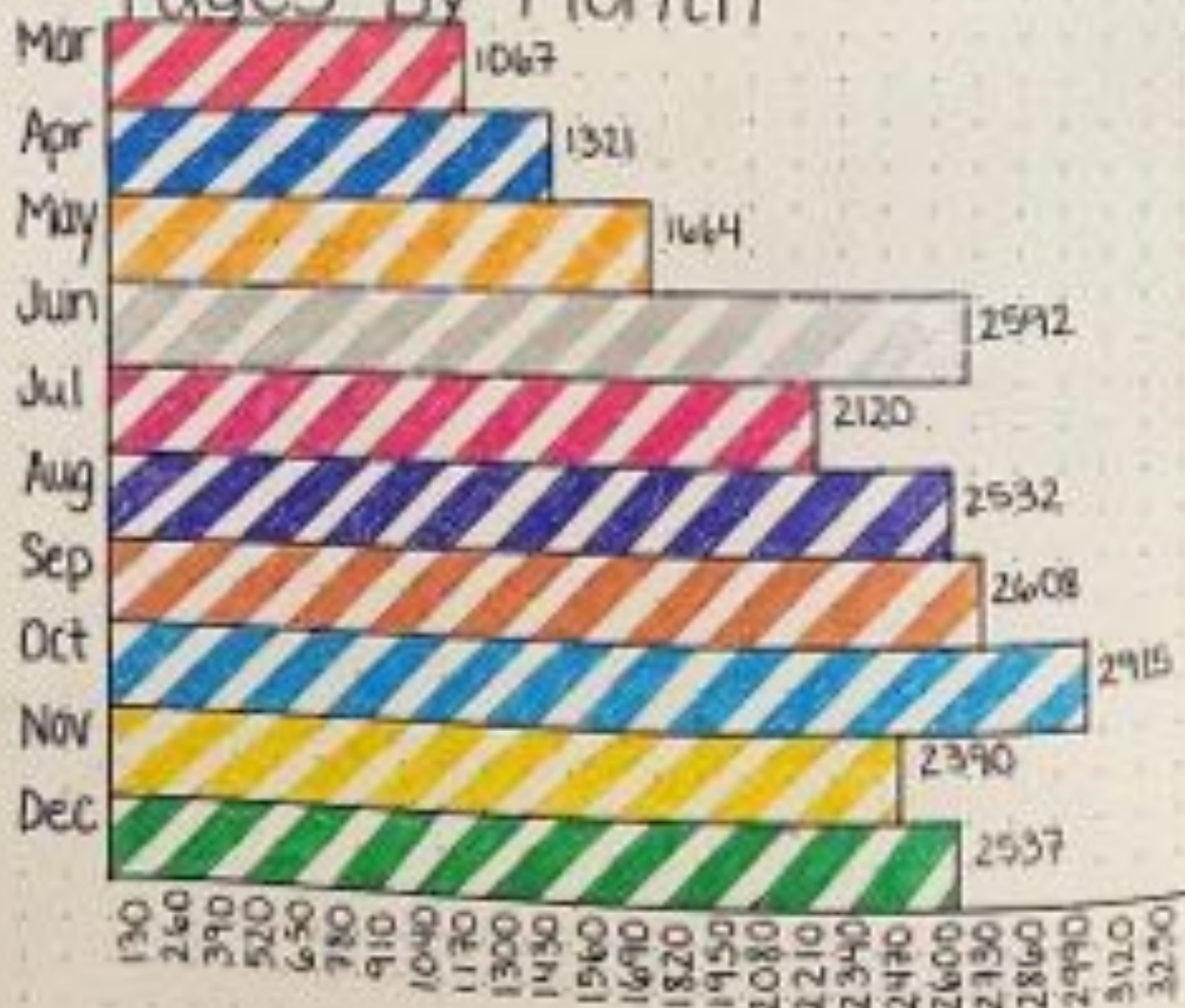

Books By Month

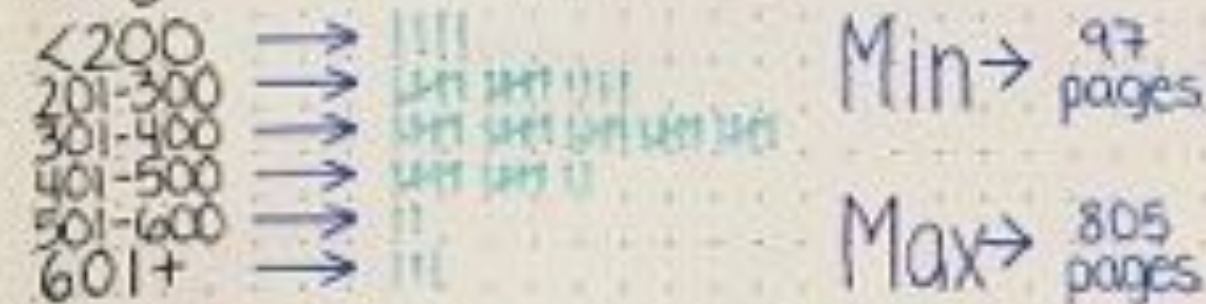


Pages By Month



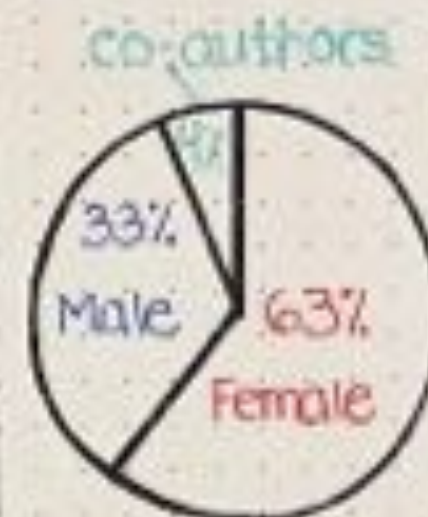

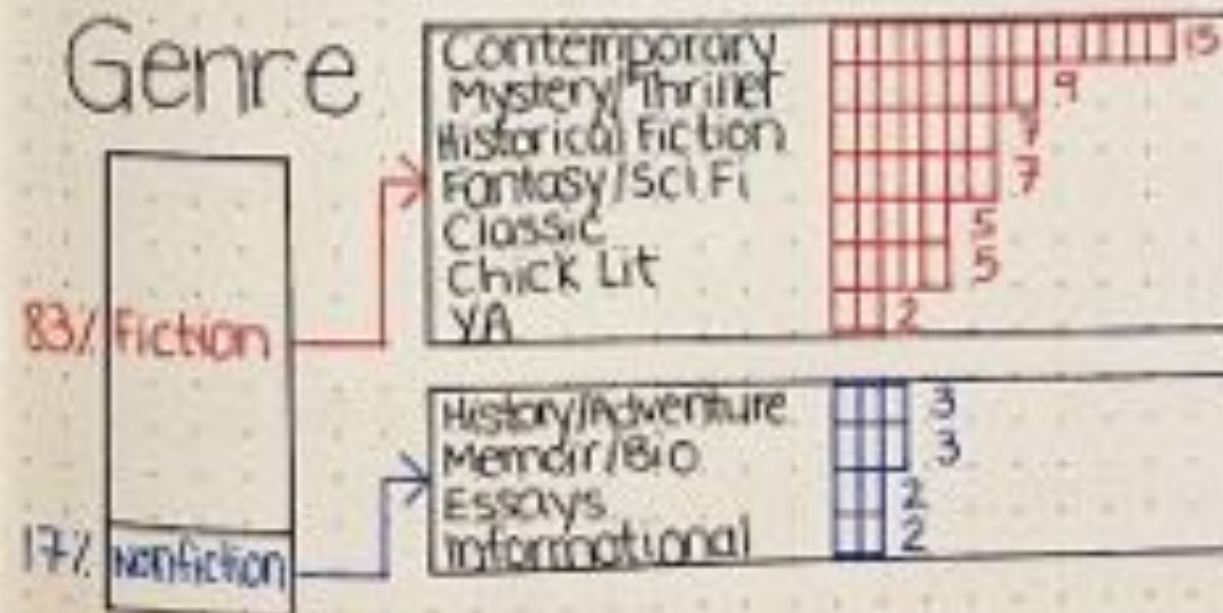

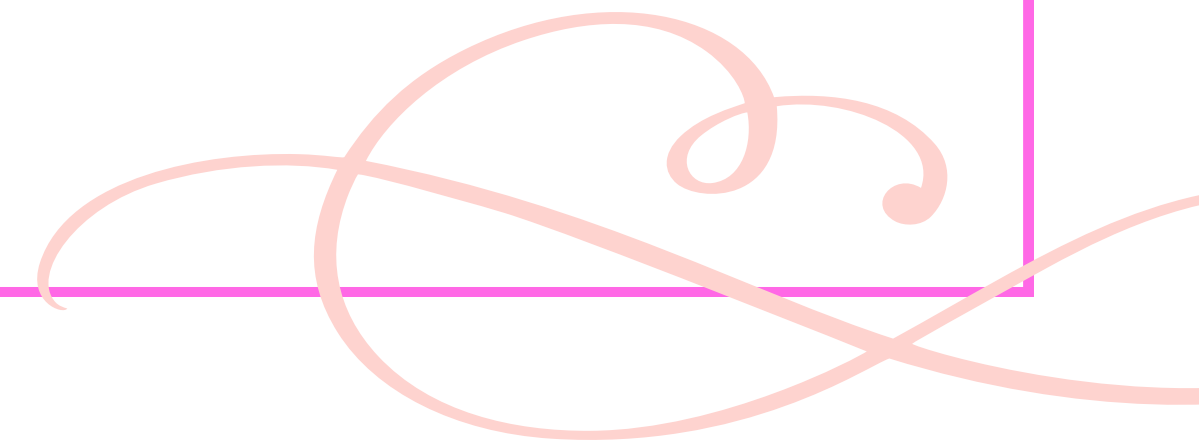

CONNECTING

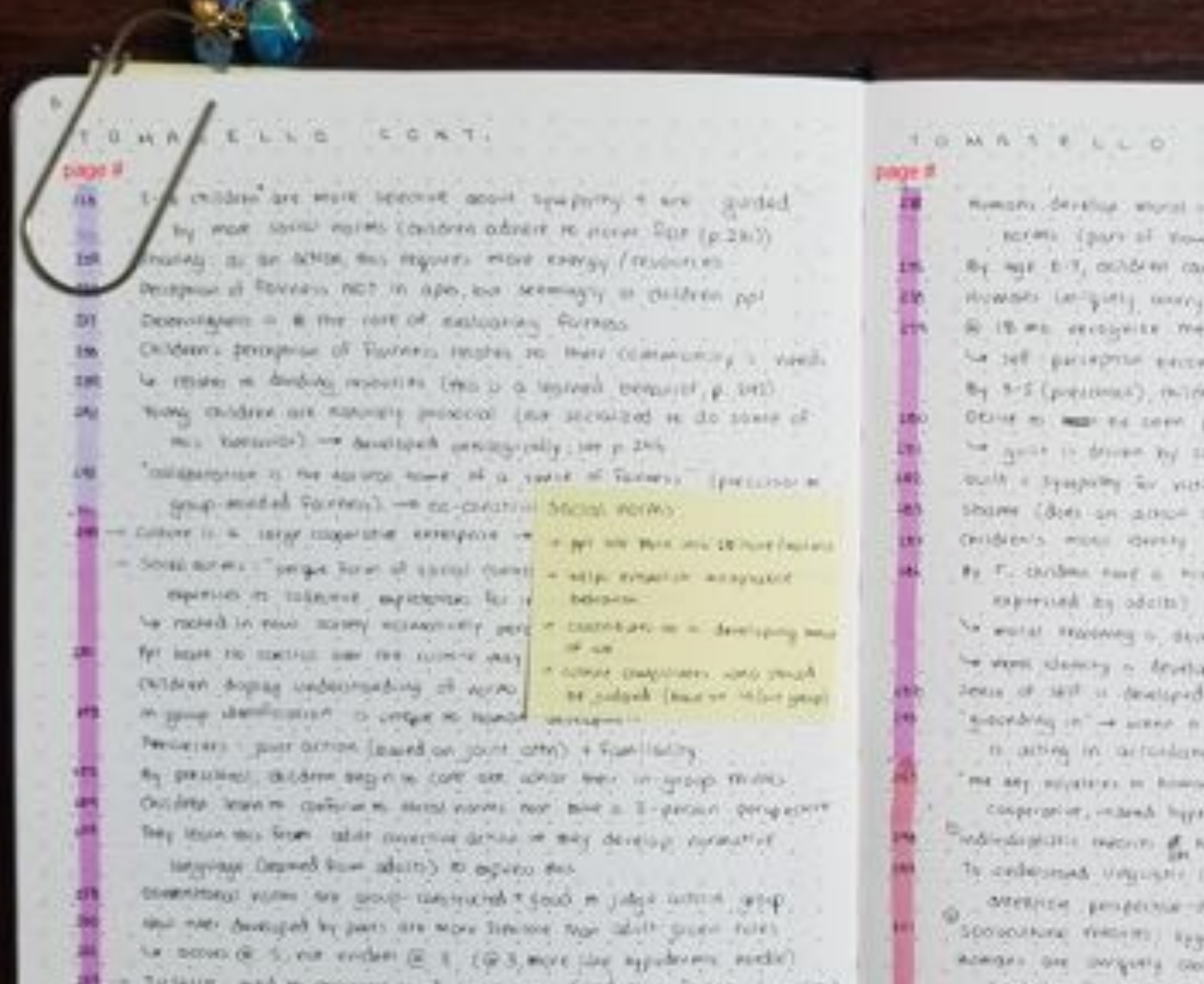
- Force yourself to slow down and process what you read on a deeper level.

- Apply the book to your life. Don't let the impact fade.

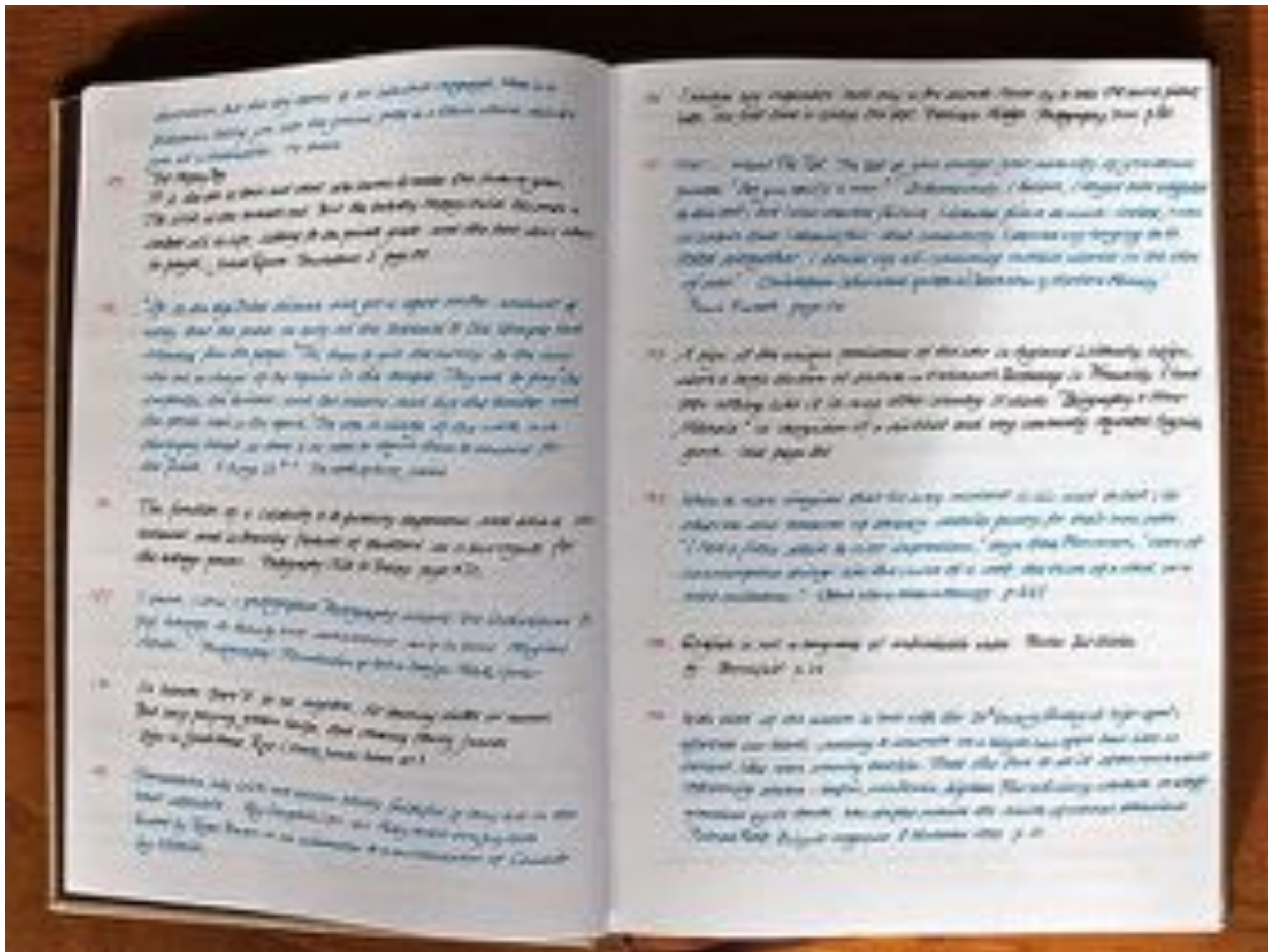


Types of Pages

- Dialogic: Running list of questions and exclamations
- Artistic expression

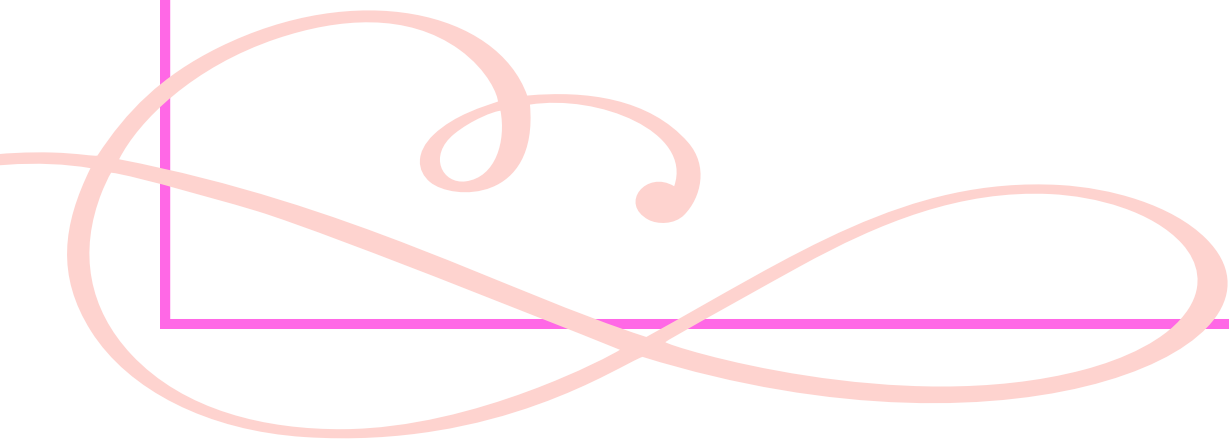
